Kappa Zeta Chapter celebrates over 75 years of leadership, service, and commitment to our community through its members and its 501©3 charitable arm, Stork's Nest Charity Fund of Dallas (SNCFD).

Through this charitable arm, Kappa Zeta Chapter has made significant contributions to the Dallas and surrounding Metroplex communities via volunteer work and outreach services. <u>Purpose</u>

The scholarship is to be awarded to high school seniors or student with a GED who has completed Storks Nest Education Program through Kappa Zeta Chapter of Zeta Phi Beta Sorority, Inc.

Eligibility Requirements

- 1. Must have completed the Storks Nest Education Program through Kappa Zeta, Zeta Phi Beta Sorority, Inc.
- 2. Must be a high school senior or completed GED within last the last year.
- 3. Must plan to pursue vocational school, trade school, or 2 or 4 year college/university within 2 years of completing the Storks Nest Education Program.
- 4. Must be a resident of Dallas County.

The Scholarship Award

The winner will be selected on the documentation and recommendations submitted. The winner will receive a scholarship in the amount of \$1000.00; with \$500 being distributed the first semester and \$500 distributed the second semester if a GPA of 2.5 or higher is maintained. The winner will be notified by the first week of February 2013. The winner will be honored in February 2013.

- 3. personal statement/resume: include information about yourself, your educational goals, and professional aspirations. Tell how this award can help you to achieve these goals and why you should receive this award.
- 4. one letter of recommendation from an educator or community leader addressed to the **Scholarship Committee of Kappa Zeta** with a signature and contact information.
- 5. an official high school transcript/copy of GED certificate
